

2009 Goats, Music, & More Festival
Rules For
Myotonic Goat Registry Sanction Shows October 9, 2009

- 1. All goats must be registered by the Myotonic Goat Registry. The ORIGINAL registration certificate MUST accompany the goat during check-in.**
- 2. Age eligibility for classes will be determined by registration certificate.**
- 3. Substitutions will be allowed at check-in within the same class.**
- 4. No percentage goats will be shown.**
- 5. First show will start at 9:00AM and second show will start immediately after dinner break or about 1:00PM.**
- 6. Goats will be released immediately after the shows on October 9, 2009..**
- 7. All goats must wear a collar or restraint when not in pens. Goat owners are responsible for securing their goats at all times.**
- 8. The show secretary reserves the right to split larger classes.**
- 9. Scrapie rules apply All goats must have a health certificate. If you use microchips you must have a reader. All tattoos must be legible. Scrapie Tags are acceptable. You must have an extra copy of the health certificate for the show committee.**
- 10. MGR rules to govern and take precedence over all others.**
- 11. Entries to be received no later then October 7, 2009.**
- 12. All goats brought to the facility must be entered in the show.**
- 13. Available rewards will be announced at the show. Goats will be placed to five places.**
- 14. Entry fee is eight dollars per goat, per show, per class. Pen fees are eight dollars per pen for the duration of the festival.**
- 15. Check-In will stop at 7:30AM on show day. You must be checked in by that time or the animals will not be allowed to be shown.**
- 16. The organizers of this show will not be responsible for any loss, damages, or accidents to animal's property or persons while participating in this show. Youth exhibitors must be accompanied by a responsible adult.**
