Official Rocky Mountain Fainting Goat Show Rules

- 1. Goats must be registered by the Myotonic Goat Registry/Miniature Silky Fainting Goat Association. A copy of the MGR/MSFGA registration <u>must accompany</u> the entry form. **Original** registration certificates are <u>must accompany</u> the animal during check in.
- 2. All Goats must have a health certificate. This includes in state goats. You must provide a copy of your health certificate for retention by the Show Committee at check in. Scrapie rules apply. If you use microchips as permanent form of identification, you must furnish a reader. Tattoos must be legible. Scrapie tags are acceptable.
- 3. All Goats must be shown with a collar. Any Goats outside of stalls must have a collar.
- 4. Show Coordinator reserves the right to split larger classes.
- 5. Private Treaty sales will be allowed.
- 6. Entry Fee: \$10 per goat, per show. \$5 per goat, per show.
- 7. This is a ribbon and points show. Any available awards will be announced at the show.
- 8. Show entries close at 9:00 am the day of the show. No changes (except scratches) will be made after that time.
- 9. To be included in the Show Program, entries **must be received no later than** Tuesday May 10,2011. Entries received later than that date will not be included in the Show Program.
- 10. Enjoy yourself! We are looking forward to having you attend our show.
