There is no charge for Showmanship.

All showmanship goats must have a health certificate.



SHOW RULES:

MGR Rules to govern and to take precedence over all others

- 1. All goats <u>must</u> be registered by the Myotonic Goat Registry. The original registration MUST accompany the goat during check-in. Pending registrations will not be accepted at check in.
- 2. Animal age eligibility for classes will be determined by birth date on registration certificate and the date of the show
- 3. Breeder's age eligibility for showmanship classes will be determined by age on the day of show.
- 4. The full correct registered name of the goat must be used on the entry form.
- 5. The goat's permanent ID (USDA Scrapie Tag, Tattoo, or Microchip) *must* be on the certificate and registered with MGR. This permanent ID *must* also match your information on your health papers!
- 6. The correct Owner name as on the registration certificate must be on the entry form, unless you have a signed MGR transfer application that is dated 45 days or less to the show date. Any Exhibitor at the show may show the goat. If the Owner is not present at the show, a signed letter from the Owner must accompany the goat stating such goat is allowed to be shown.
- 7. Goats should be checked in between 12pm 8pm on Friday, May 24th or Saturday, May 25th between 8 10am. Please advise us of your arrival plans if outside of these hours.
- 8. All goats are to be removed from Howard County Fairgrounds *no later than 6pm on Sunday. May* <u>26th</u>. If you need to keep goats longer, please contact Jen Pahl to make alternate arrangements.
- 9. All goats <u>must</u> have accompanied with them a valid health certificate of veterinary inspection signed by an accredited veterinarian. This certificate should not be dated any more than 120 days prior to the show if goats originated in Maryland. Out of state goats must have a health certificate not to be dated any more than 30 days prior to show. It should include the animals' names and identifications <u>as stated on the MGR registration certificates</u>.
- 10. You <u>must</u> either email a copy of your health certificate to <u>masondixonmyotonicgoatclub@gmail.com</u> OR bring an extra copy of your health certificate that will be retained/photographed by the show secretary. Keep your original & show it during check-in.
- 11. Substitutions will be allowed at no charge as long as the animal is on the health certificate.
- 12. Goats may be sold by private treaty; however, please ensure they are on your health certificate and entered in at least one show.
- 13. All goats must be shown with a halter, collar or chain. NO prong collars for Platinum Wethers.
- 14. Show Secretary reserves the right to split large classes according to birth date.
- 15. Please read & understand MGR sanction rules regarding wethering & castrations.
- 16. Entry Fee: \$8.00 per goat/ per show. There is NO entry fee for Showmanship.
- 17. **Trailer Load Special. Unlimited class entries for \$300 for MDMGC members.** Pen fees apply.
- Pen Fee: \$15. Pens are 6x6 livestock stalls on a dirt floor. Bedding removal is included in the pen fees. Bedding can be brought in or you may pre-purchase bags of shavings at \$10 each. One tack stall per exhibitor is free please designate on the entry form.
- 19. There is a one time late entry fee of \$30 if entries are received after May 17th.

- **20.** No refunds of entry fees, unless the show is canceled.
- 21. If anyone shows signs of unsportsmanlike conduct or inappropriate behavior, they will be asked to leave the ring and/or show facility. There are no refunds.
- 22. The Show Management, the facility (Howard County Fairgrounds) and the Mason Dixon Myotonic Goat Club will not be liable for any loss, damages or accidents to animals, persons or property while participating in the show. Howard County Fairgrounds is not responsible for injury or death to person or animals or loss of property due to theft, fire or accident
- 23. Any item that comes up that is not specifically covered by these rules will be decided by the show management and their decision will be final.
- 24. All breeders and exhibitors must follow all rules and regulations of Howard County Fairgrounds and the Myotonic Goat Registry.
- 25. MGR Rules to govern and to take precedence over all others.
