



MGR Platinum Wether Program

MGR has created a new wether program for our MGR sanctioned shows. It is named the MGR Platinum Wether Program.

This new program allows wethers to show as often as their owner chooses to show them until they earn the “Platinum” title. At that time they will be retired from the sanctioned show ring. They will still be eligible to compete for the title “National Champion Wether” and they may compete in champion challenge classes (non-sanctioned) if a show decides to offer such classes.

Certificates will be issued to the owner after the goat records 3 wins:

Bronze	–	3 recorded wins
Silver	–	6 recorded wins
Gold	–	9 recorded wins
Platinum	–	12 recorded wins

Wethers will be qualified to compete for National Champion wether after they have recorded at least 3 wins.

Questions and answers

1. Will wethers still compete for the title of Permanent Grand Champion.

No, the platinum program is replacing the previous program for wethers.

2. Will wethers need to be held until they reach the next age level (senior division) before competing after recording a win.

No. Wethers may be shown continually until they have recorded 12 wins.

3. What changes will this cause for show secretaries of MGR shows?

No change. The show secretary will fill out the report of awards forms just as they do for buck and doe classes. Send all report of award forms to MGR and MGR will record the wins for your exhibitors.
